Junction of Fulham Road and Sydney Place: works from 14 March

I am writing to let you know that from 14 March to 31 March 2022 we will work to replace the existing traffic island at the junction of Fulham Road and Sydney Place.

These works will enable new double deck electric buses on route 49 – which are longer than those currently running on the route – to safely manoeuvre through the junction.

How our works may affect you

We will work on weekdays from 08:00 to 18:00, and from 08:00 to 13:00 on Saturdays. These working hours have been agreed with the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.

We will make every effort to complete the works on time. However, poor weather conditions or events in the area may mean we need to reschedule works at short notice.

Traffic

Single lane closures will be in place on Sydney Place and Fulham Road on the approaches to the junction for the duration of the works. If you plan to drive, please allow more time to complete your journey.

Pedestrians

The pedestrian crossing at the junction of Sydney Place with Fulham Road will be closed for the duration of the works.

We will clearly signpost the temporary closure, and a safe pedestrian diversion route will be provided.


Buses

During the works, buses will not stop at Onslow Square (Stop HT), and Onslow Square (Stop HV) on Sydney Place. We will put signage on the suspended bus stops to direct customers to the nearest alternative stop. Visit tfl.gov.uk/bus/status for live updates.
